

ENTRY FORM: 2019 FSRA ESSAY COMPETITION

Topic:

1. Discuss Money Laundering (ML) in the Capital Markets. NB: A completed essay should answer the following questions:

- **What is a Capital Market?**
- **What is Money Laundering (ML)?**
- **How can the Capital Markets be used as a vehicle for Money Laundering?**
- **What are the effects of Money Laundering in the Capital Markets?**
- **What measures can the Financial Services Regulatory Authority (FSRA) take to eliminate or curb Money Laundering? (100 Marks)**

Competition Rules:

- The competition is open to only students from Form 4 and 5. However, in cases where the school offer education up to junior certificate level students in Form 3 will be allowed to participate in the competition.
- Participants who made it to the top three (3) from previous FSRA High School Essay Competitions, are barred from this year's competition.
- Entries must be written in English and be the original work of the writer, including proper referencing. Plagiarised work will not be accepted.
- The maximum word count must not be more than 2,000 words.
- Entrants are encouraged to be creative in their response to the topic.
- Plagiarised work will not be accepted.
- Award-winning entrants are expected to show originality, focus on topic and competent use of English as a written language. This includes correct spelling, a good standard of punctuation and neat presentation.
- Essays can either be sent electronically to essay@fsra.co.sz or hand-delivered at the FSRA offices; **Second Floor, Ingcamu Building, Mhlambanyatsi Road, Mbabane.**
- There is no limit to entrants for each selected school but only genuine students are allowed to enter.
- The FSRA's Panel of judges decision is final
- Late submissions will not be accepted.
- Entries are open from **01 April to 20 May 2019.**
